"Thinking of you, Jim"

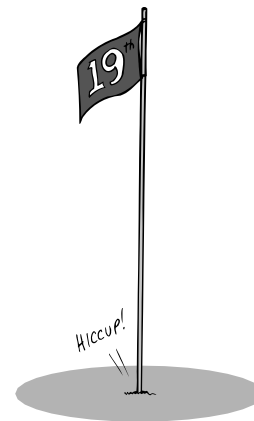

Skywest in Hayward is a flat track with open fairway's. There are many trees lining the fairway's and a few sand bunkers to contend with. Only 1 or 2 water holes come into play. The afternoon wind combined with a lengthy layout will test your game. Nice course for walking if you feel like stretching your legs.

Comments:

With it's large undulating greens, thick rough, and tree lined fairways, Poppy Hills is a bear of a course even from the white tees. The course features 5 par five's and long par three's. There are quite a few dogleg holes to keep you on your toes. Quite a bargain for NCGA members. With it's serene setting in the Del Monte Forest and occasional views of the Pacific in the distance you wont find a better deal on the Monterey Peninsula.

Comments:

This links - style course is nestled among Lodi's grape vineyards. It has 8 lakes that come into play on a number of holes. There are generous landing area's for your tee shots but the errant drive may catch a few strategically placed fairway bunker's. There is a mixture of easy holes and difficult one's too. The signature hole is #14, a 179 yard par 3, requiring a tee shot over water to a green framed by railroad ties in front. Play well and your score will reflect it.
