Don't forget to Rake

Excerpt from *Golf Etiquette*, by Barbara Puett and Jim Apfelbaum, (c) 1992

Before you enter a bunker, first find the rake and place it nearby. You are obligated to provide a little interim maintenance, raking footprints and marks after you play in consideration of the next player. A ball that lands in a footprint is as unpleasant as finding a shot nestled in a fairway divot. When you have played your ball free, retrace your steps, raking backward. Leave the rake just inside the bunker's edge, face down and out of the way.

Don't chuck it. Extra clubs (putter, wedge) must be left outside the bunker, or you'd be "grounding" your clubs. If your ball comes to rest against the rake, as sometimes happens, simply remove the rake and play the ball where it lies. There is no penalty if the ball moves.
