Certificates Update

The Pro Shop at Sunnyvale has asked the board to pass on a few new messages regarding the certs they distribute to us for our winnings. Currently it is a receipt type slip that looks like an ATM record. You must hang on to these. As easy as they are to discard, the Shop gets credit from the City of Sunnyvale when they are redeemed. If you should misplace them, the staff in the shop can recover these slips by **"your name"**. However, this current system has only been in place since Oct 1, 2006. If you have certs prior to that and lose them, they cannot be recovered. After Oct 1, the Shop has a running tally of your winnings. **Keep the slips for your records**, just in case they have a different cumulative total.
